Abstract:

The lecture aims to provide an overview of the development of psychoanalytic child observation in the "Zeitschrift für psychoanalytische Pädagogik" in the interwar period. The most important representatives and their methods of observation will be presented. By analyzing case studies and discussing the influences on these child observations, a deeper understanding of the developments in psychoanalytic pedagogy at the time will be conveyed. The lecture concludes with an attempt to critically reflect on the concept of observation as such and to discuss possible consequences for contemporary forms of child observation.
